HOW DO I ENROLL?

From start to finish the enrollment process can take up to 30 days. However, our Intake Team is here to walk you through the enrollment process.

Step 1 - Register with the <u>Maryland Workforce Exchange</u> (MWE)

- Connect with hiring employers.
- Register for upcoming hiring events.

Step 2 - Complete Referral Form to WSM

- Job Seekers must complete the <u>WIOA Referral Form</u>.
- Referring organizations must complete the <u>Partner</u> WIOA Referral Form.

Step 3 - Attend Virtual Information Session

• Information sessions are held every Monday at 10:00 am and Thursday at 2:00 pm.

Step 4 - Upload Eligibility Documents into MWE

• Scan QR code for Eligibility Document Checklist.

Step 5 - Your One-on-One Intake Appointment

- If eligibility documents are uploaded, the Intake Specialist will call and email you to schedule an appointment.
 - If eligibility documents are missing, the Intake Specialist will call and email you about the required documentation you need to upload in order to schedule an appointment.

Step 6 - Complete Intake Appointment & Enrollment

- Intake appointments are available virtually and inperson at the Germantown & Wheaton locations.
 - Plan for at least 1 hour for your appointment.
